**Parish Advisory Council:** Peter attended the recent meeting. The PAC Chairman has asked that representatives seek ways to "reach out" to parishioners. We need to tell people about our meetings and our activities, mention the Justice and Peace group when promoting the Food Collection. Merton Listening Project: This is being organised by Citizens UK including the Salvation Army. They aim to gain responses from 4,000 people, (5% of the Merton population) on what they would like to see in Merton. The project is being sponsored by several Merton Churches.
